ADDENDUM NO. 2

The following shall be incorporated into the captioned solicitation as though included in the original documents issued:

Contractor shall be responsible for meeting all conditions identified in the following documents provided as separate attachments:

1. Maintenance of Traffic Special Conditions (12 pages)
2. State Highway Administration of Maryland Permit Document No. 13-AP-HA-007-15 dated January 5, 2015 (12 pages)

Clarifications:

1. BGE will be responsible for relocating the overhead power lines and their buried power lines prior to the beginning of the road work.
2. BGE will relocate the one (1) meter pedestal located near the College sign.
3. Buried fiber optic cables owned by Harford County have already been relocated as part of a separate project.

Questions/Answers

Q1: Are MD State Wage Rates to be included in this project?

A1: No

Q2: Are there any MBD/DBE Goals or requirements set for this project?

A2: No

Q3: In the Invitation for Bid document section 8.2 (Project Scope)... Item 2 states that contractor is to identify existing underground utilities and relocate where necessary. The plan set shows Overhead/Underground Utilities being relocated by BGE. What other utilities are known to be present? Please clarify

A3: 8.2 is referencing work associated with new directional drilling and trenching that is shown on the Signalization Plan. These are identified on sheet 1 as notes D, E, O. All existing utilities must be identified and protected during this work.

Work associated with notes H and K will be completed by others under a separate contract.

Q4: Does Harford Community College have a need for excess topsoil/fill material anywhere on the Campus?

A4: No

Q5: Since SHA inspections will apply to this project, will temporary offices or SHA testing equipment be required as part of the Contractor's scope?

A5: No

Q6: I cannot locate a specification regarding EXCAVATION on this project. Will excavation in rock conditions be considered an extra to the project?

A6: Yes.
